Positive Points delivers 300 care packages to Dover AFB

DOVER — Five busloads of kids and seniors recently delivered care packages to Dover AFB for delivery to overseas troops as part of a community services program called Positive Points.

Positive Points provides opportunities for residents in 19 affordable housing developments in Delaware and nearby states to make contributions to their communities through programs such as this year's "Support the Troops" project. Residents met regularly during a six-week period to create more than 300 care packages, which included making cookies, cards, pillows and candy bags and collecting toiletries for the troops overseas.



The care packages were delivered to Dover AFB on Aug. 15 as the finale of their summer Positive Points Program. The field trip included a tour of the Air Mobility Command Museum.

Now in its fifth year, the Positive Points Program is sponsored by the Leon N. Weiner Education Foundation, which provides educational support to children of low- to moderate-income families.
