

**ANNOUNCING THE
LEON N. WEINER EDUCATION FOUNDATION
2012 SCHOLARSHIP**

**FOR RESIDENTS OF PROPERTIES OWNED OR MANAGED BY
LEON N. WEINER & ASSOCIATES, INC. AFFILIATED COMPANIES**

The Leon N. Weiner Education Foundation (LNWEF) is a nonprofit foundation established to provide educational support primarily to students living in properties owned or managed by Leon N. Weiner and Associates, Inc. ("LNWA") affiliated companies.

ELIGIBILITY

To be eligible for this scholarship an applicant must be:

1. A U.S. citizen or legal resident of the U.S.,
2. A resident of a property owned and/or managed by LNWA affiliated companies,
3. A senior at or graduate of a public or private high school or recipient of a GED certificate, and
4. Planning to enroll full- or half-time in an accredited two- or four-year college, university or vocational/technical school in the fall of 2012.

AWARD

LNWEF will award scholarships of up to \$2500.00 per year. Scholarships are not automatically renewable, but applicants may reapply in subsequent years.

USE OF SCHOLARSHIP FUNDS

Scholarship funds must be used for tuition, room and board and/or other education-related expenses. All scholarship funds will be disbursed directly to the school on the awardee's behalf. The customary procedure will be to disburse such funds in two equal payments for two semesters.

AWARD CRITERIA

Scholarships are awarded on the basis of:

- Scholastic standing
- Standardized test results
- Contributions to the school and community/extracurricular activities
- Work experience

- Financial need
- Career and educational aspirations and goal

APPLICATION

- Applicants who have not received a LNWEF Scholarship previously must complete **LNWEF Scholarship Application Form A**.
- Applicants who have received a scholarship in the previous academic year may reapply using **LNWEF Scholarship Application Form B**.

APPLICATION DEADLINE

To be considered, the completed application form and all the following supporting materials must be emailed or postmarked on or before **March 30, 2012**. The following constitutes a **complete application**:

1. All pages of this application including the signed and dated signature page.
2. An official sealed transcript(s) as specified in the application.
3. Two letters of recommendation as defined in the application.
4. A photocopy of the applicant's and legal guardian's Free Application for Federal Student Aid Forms (FAFSA) for the school year during which the applicant will be enrolled.
5. A copy of the SAT scores for high school seniors & college freshmen, if taken. (Note: Not required with Application Form B.)
6. A copy of Graduate Record Exams scores, if applicable.

NOTIFICATION OF AWARDS

All candidates will be notified of their standing by *May 31, 2012*.
